### Safe Stranger/Not Safe Stranger Card Sort Game

### Objective

Group cards under the category of Safe Stranger or Not Safe Stranger

### Prep

Print and cut out the 2 labels and 18 stranger cards. Print on card stock and laminate for more durability.

#### Instructions

- Place the 2 labels on the floor, table, or wherever you're playing.
- Shuffle the cards and turn them face down in a pile.
- Have your child take one card at a time .
- Read who is on the card and explain a little. For example:
  - " Is your grandfather you're meeting for the first time a safe stranger?"
  - " We don't know this lady but she looks friendly and nice and she's trying to share candy with you."
- Have them place it under the proper label heading.

### Preschool-friendly definitions

#### Safe Strangers

- A safe stranger is someone your parents (or a trusted adult) know or introduce you too.
- Community helpers like doctors and firefighters are also safe strangers.


#### Not Safe Strangers


 People you and your parents( or a trusted adult) don't know – even if they look nice and friendly.

#### **Trusted Adult**

 Someone you know and your parents trust such as family members, your parent's friends or a Sunday School Teacher. So, if your Sunday School Teacher introduces you to a new teacher, that would be a safe stranger.





















